



Senate Bill 7026 was enacted July 1, 2018 as a measure to ensure the safety and well-being of our school aged students who require or benefit from mental health/behavioral/substance abuse intervention services.

All Florida schools are required to implement a multi-tiered level of service that will be offered in the school setting. Parents/guardians will be encouraged to actively communicate and collaborate with school mental health professional personnel regarding their child's individual needs.

In an effort to meet the service needs of all UCP of Central Florida students and families, and comply with SB 7026 parents are required to submit the following form with their back to school or enrollment packet.

This information will remain confidential based on FERPA and HIPPA guidelines and will only be provided to the mental health professional(s) providing services.
